1. Was your jurisdiction aware of the new 2007 California Plumbing Code Chapter 16A Emergency Graywater Standards adopted by the California Building Standards Commission and that became effective throughout the state on August 4, 2009 for occupancies regulated by HCD?
  - a. We were aware of the emergency standards.
  - b. We were **not** aware of the emergency standards **until now**.
