Applications are now being accepted for the 2010 SVABO Bob Stoddard Scholarship, established in the memory of Bob Stoddard, a longtime member of the Sacramento Valley Association of Building Officials. Bob was devoted to the work of quality codes and uniform enforcement and was a supporter of educational programs for persons pursuing a career in building code enforcement. In this spirit, SVABO is offering scholarships to persons enrolled or enrolling in a Building Inspection Technology program.

### **Rules and Conditions of Scholarship Award:**

Eligibility for the 2010 SVABO Bob Stoddard Scholarship is limited to persons enrolled or enrolling in a recognized Building Inspection Technology program within the SVABO service area. Membership in SVABO is required. Membership applications are available at the SVABO web site ([www.svabo.org](http://www.svabo.org)).

The scholarship must be for attendance at a college, trade school, or similar institution of learning with a Building Inspection Technology degree or certification program.

Awards amounts are contingent upon the organizational budget and will not exceed \$1,000 to any one individual in any single year. The funds must be used within the twelve-month period commencing on November 1 following the award. All award checks will be made out in the name of the applicant and will be used exclusively for the Building Inspection Technology course fees, materials and related expenses (i.e. costs for job interview items such as travel, clothing, resumes, etc.).

Persons awarded a scholarship must agree to the use of their name and some of the information regarding their educational goal as stated in the required application for purposes of announcing the award and promotion of the SVABO Bob Stoddard Scholarship.

All awards are made at the sole discretion of the 2010 SVABO Scholarship Committee. Award information will not be given over the telephone.

Awards will be dispersed upon receiving documentation of satisfactory completion of current educational session (i.e. grades, letter from Dean).

The eligible application period is from August 1, 2010 to September 30, 2010. **Applications must be postmarked by September 30, 2010.** Applications must be filled out completely and typed or neatly printed with the required information and attachments.
